

Whetstone: Art and Design

Whetstone Field Primary School follows a thematic curriculum. Art and Design is planned around a specific topic which gives children the opportunity to develop their designing and artistic skills but also allows them to take these experiences and use it in other subjects such as their writing during Literacy.

The school follows the objectives set out in the Essentials Curriculum to ensure that all children have the opportunity to experience a range of art skills and learn to design, make and evaluate art throughout the year.

Here is a list of topics which will be covered in 2018/2019. Since the start of 2018 two Year groups have been working together on the same topic. This ensures that children have the opportunity to revisit skills across both year groups. In Years 1, 3 and 5 children will study at a basic and advancing level and as they go into 2, 4 and 6 children will consolidate the advancing skills and become deeper learners.
