Dear Parents,

As the weather begins to get warmer children will be spending more time outside during the school day and we want to ensure that they are protected when exposed to the sun.

We ask that parents apply all day sun cream first thing in the morning if the forecast is sunny. In Nursery and Reception, as children spend more time outside than the rest of the school and have more sensitive skin, staff may choose to reapply cream in exceptional circumstances such as Sports Day, but this will be a generic cream purchased by school. If your child has any allergies related to sun cream then please let the class teacher know.

In KS1 and KS2 we again ask parents or the child themselves to apply all day cream first thing in the morning but, due to allergies and possible issues with sharing, we don't allow children to bring their cream into school. KS1 and KS2 children are also asked to bring in a water bottle each day (filled with water only) in order to stay hydrated.

We would also ask that you ensure that your child has a suitable hat for protection on hot days.

If there are exceptional circumstances relating to your child's skin, please call in at the office and collect a form relating to sun cream use.
