Within school we have a detailed Action Plan and Business Continuity Plan to ensure that we follow correct procedures should any event occur. We have been contacted by some parents asking if children can bring in antibacterial gel. We are happy for you to send your child with gel but it MUST be in the original bottle, labelled with your child's name and class. Children will be asked to store them in a central place in the classroom and given specific times to use them, such as after playtime, before lunch, after returning from the toilet etc. Children must not keep the gel in their bag or take it outside with them. We will continue to remind children about the importance of handwashing and stress that the use of antibacterial gel DOES NOT replace the need for hands to be washed thoroughly.
