

Whetstone Field Primary School – Pupil Premium Report

Pupil Premium 2012-2013

The Pupil Premium was introduced in April 2011. Schools were allocated additional funding to support children from low-income families who were eligible for free school meals, looked after children and those from families with parents in the Armed Forces. The table below outlines how the additional funding was allocated and spent at Whetstone Field Primary School during the 2012-2013 academic year. Our actual pupil premium allocation was £15,552; school budget was used to supplement this to improve outcomes for all pupils in our school.

Summary of Impact – 2012-2013

Key Stage One (Years 1 and 2)

Overall in Reading, pupils attained levels above those expected for their age. They also made at least expected progress. In writing overall, pupils attained levels that were in line with the expected levels for their age but pupils made less progress. In Mathematics, attainment is above age-related expectations and progress is above the national expectations.

Key Stage Two (Years 3 to 6)

Overall, in reading, writing and mathematics, pupils' attainment is above age-related expectations. Broadly, in reading, pupils make better than expected progress. Typically, pupils make at least expected progress in mathematics and writing.

Summary of Impact 2013-2014

Key Stage One (Years 1 and 2)

In writing, the gap between PP and non-PP narrowed over the year in terms of attainment. Progress was broadly in line with non-PP children.

In Maths, the gap narrowed between PP and non-PP children. PP children made more progress than the non-PP children

In Reading, the gap was still evident and progress was slightly less than non-PP children. This will remain a focus area for KS1

Key Stage Two (Years 3-6)

In Reading, the Progress and Attainment of PP children was higher than non-PP children

In Writing, the Progress and Attainment of PP children was higher than non-PP children

In Mathematics, progress and attainment of PP children was broadly in line with non-PP children.
