Dear Parents,

Following a few recent queries from parents this is a reminder about our uniform expectations for school.

## **Normal / Winter (October Half-Term until Easter)**

- Red jumper or cardigan
- White shirt (red polo shirts are not permitted during this time)
- School tie - may be purchased from the school office, priced at £3.50
- Grey flannel trousers (boys or girls) / pleated grey skirt OR grey pinafore (girls)
- Boys - Grey Socks
- Girls - White socks or red/white/grey tights
- Sensible flat, black shoes (NO TRAINERS)
- In extreme weather conditions, small ankle boots are acceptable. If children wear larger boots to school on other days, they must change into their shoes once they arrive at school.

## **Summer (Optional) (Easter until October Half-Term)**

- Boys - Short sleeved red polo shirt, grey trousers (short or long), red jumper
- Girls - Red checked dress or red jumper / cardigan
- If sandals are worn, they must be black, red or white, flat, and not open toed or 'strappy'. Rubber beach shoes (crocs) are not suitable.
- During these months, children can still wear the 'normal' uniform if they wish.
  
- Nail varnish is not allowed at any time.
- Headbands / Bobbles etc are allowed but large bows are not permitted. Long hair must be tied back please.
- Small studs in ears and watches are acceptable but no other jewellery to be worn please.

## **P.E. Kit**

Children should have black shorts, a red t-shirt, grey tracksuit, pumps and trainers for every lesson. In addition to this if children have had ears pierced then they need to be able to take them out themselves. If it is within 6 weeks of them being pierced, children should bring their own tape to cover them but please try to keep to the summer holidays for this wherever possible. Furthermore, if for any reason your child cannot take part in P.E (e.g. illness or injury) please can you send in a note explaining why, otherwise they will be expected to take a full part in the lesson.
